



Summary: Grant funding has allowed us to continue focused invasive Aedes control efforts which is now our Aedes Support Team (AST). A four member support team is supporting field specialists to conduct inspections, control and service request response for the invasive mosquitoes specifically. Service requests this month totaled to more than double the amount from last month. The San Gabriel River is no longer importing water for the rest of the year, which should allow the black fly production to slow into winter months. This decreases the flow of water and will also allow the Santa Fe Dam spreading grounds to dry up around the area that was previously confirmed with mosquitoes testing positive for WNv. Most of the spreading grounds and debris basins throughout the District have been cleaned out by LA County Public Works on their annual schedule in preparation for the raining season.

Collections highlighted in red indicate the locations of the 2 pools that were positive for WNv for the month of October from CO2 or gravid traps. Five additional pools collected from BG traps used in *Aedes* collections were also positive for WNv in the cities of El Monte, Monterey Park, and Temple City. In California for 2017, there are currently 3,350 WNv positive mosquito pools from 26 counties; 568 from Los Angeles County, 150 in the District.

II. Dead Birds

In October, one dead bird collected in Monrovia tested WNv. There were 24 WNv+ dead birds in the District for 2017. WestNile.ca.gov reports 484 dead birds from 39 counties positive for WNv in 2017; 93 of these were from Los Angeles County.

III. Sentinel Chicken Sera

One chicken in the City of Industry coop tested positive for WNv in October. In California during 2017, 304 chickens have tested positive for WNv; 144 from Los Angeles County, 18 in the District from 6 locations.

IV. Human Illness

Seven additional cases of human infection with WNv were reported in the District since last month's report bringing the current total to 40 for 2017. In October the number of cases nearly doubled for both Los Angeles county and the state of California; Los Angeles County still accounts for nearly half (231) of the 427 reported WNv illnesses in California. There are 24 WNv-related fatalities reported in California for 2017 including 16 from Los Angeles County.

V. Horses


Twenty horses have been reported positive for WNv across the state of California in 2017, one from Los Angeles County.

VI. Aedes albopictus

In October, there were 2014 invasive Aedes inspections with 234 sites positive for Aedes albopictus and 51 Ae. aegypti identifications including new locations in Claremont. In 2017, Ae. albopictus has been found at 1559 sites, Ae. aegypti at 148 sites, three finds for Ae. notoscriptus. Please see attached map.

VII. Black Fly

In October, black fly adults were found in carbon-dioxide baited traps in the cities of Altadena, Azusa, Glendora, La Puente, and Monterey Park. Black fly larvae were collected in Azusa, Glendora, and Walnut.




